

How to Retire from Sport

If you have a membership and compete for any of the FEI disciplines either as a national or international athlete, you must notify British Equestrian when you retire

Who does this apply to?	What happens next?
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If you are an athlete who competes under FEI rules you must contact the FEI & British Equestrian by email. 2. If you are a national level athlete, you must contact your national governing body and British Equestrian 3. If you are an athlete who is on the Testing Pool (whereabouts) contact the FEI and British Equestrian 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. International level athletes and registered testing pool athletes -The FEI through the International testing agency will contact you via email, confirming your retirement to you and your NGB. 2. National level athletes -British Equestrian will contact you confirming your retirement to you and your NGB.

Important Reminders

- ❖ Retirement applies to all athletes regardless of your level of competition
- ❖ If British Equestrian/FEI and your NGB aren't officially notified, you are still subject to out of competition human Anti-Doping testing and could be subject to an Anti-Doping rule violation
- ❖ You must comply with Anti- Doping regardless of personal retirement status.
