The idea is to use the internet and social media to collect relatively small amounts of money from a large number of people, usually in return for incentives and rewards. There are a number of organisations who offer this service (the crowdfunder website is just one example). You'll need to select an organisation that meets your needs, so carefully read about what they offer in relation to the percentage of the money raised that they take.
